

## New Codes for Neonatology from the American Academy of Pediatrics effective January 1, 2009

### Newborn Care

- 99431            **99460** Initial hospital or birthing center care, per day, for the evaluation and management of the normal newborn infant
- 99432            **99461** Initial care, per day, for the evaluation and management of the normal newborn infant seen in other than hospital or birthing center
- 99433            **99462** Subsequent hospital care, per day, for the evaluation and management of a normal newborn
- 99435            **99463** Initial hospital or birthing center care, per day, for the evaluation and management of the normal newborn infant admitted and discharged on the same date
- 99436            **99464** Attendance at delivery (when requested by the delivering physician) and initial stabilization of newborn
- 99440            **99465** Delivery/birthing room Newborn resuscitation: provision of positive pressure ventilation and/or chest compressions in the presence of acute inadequate ventilation and/or cardiac output

### Inpatient Neonatal Intensive Care Services and Pediatric and Neonatal Critical Care Services

#### Initial and Continuing Intensive Care Services

- σ99477            Initial hospital care, per day, for the evaluation and management of the neonate, 28 days of age or less, who requires intensive observation, frequent interventions, and other intensive care services
- 99298            **99478** **Subsequent intensive care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of the recovering very low birth weight infant (present body weight less than 1500 grams)
- 99299            **99479** **Subsequent intensive care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of the recovering low birth weight infant (present body weight of 1500-2500 grams)
- 99300            **99480** **Subsequent intensive care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of the recovering infant (present body weight of 2501-5000 grams)

#### Pediatric Critical Care Patient Transport

- 99289            **99466** **Critical care** services delivered by a physician, face-to-face, during an interfacility transport of critically ill or critically injured pediatric patient, 24 months of age or less; first 30-74 minutes of hands on care during transport

99290            **99467**        each additional 30 minutes (List separately in addition to code for primary service)

**Inpatient Neonatal and Pediatric Critical Care**

99295            **99468**    **Initial inpatient neonatal critical care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of a critically ill neonate, 28 days of age or less

99296            **99469**    **Subsequent inpatient neonatal critical care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of a critically ill neonate, 28 days of age or less

99293            **99471**    **Initial inpatient pediatric critical care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of a critically ill infant or young child, 29 days through 24 months of age

99294            **99472**    **Subsequent inpatient pediatric critical care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of a critically ill infant or young child, 29 days through 24 months of age

λ**99475**            **Initial inpatient pediatric critical care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of a critically ill infant or young child, ~~2 through 5 years 25 months through 71 months~~ of age

λ**99476**            **Subsequent inpatient pediatric critical care**, per day, for the evaluation and management of a critically ill infant or young child, ~~2 through 5 years 25 months through 71 months~~ of age
