Membership Categories

U.S. or Canada

U.S. or Canada membership is open to any registered nurse who wants to support neonatal nursing and NANN and who lives in the United States or Canada. These members have the right to vote in NANN elections and may work on committees and hold office.

International

International membership is open to any registered nurse who wants to support neonatal nursing and NANN and who lives outside of the United States or Canada. International members have the right to vote in NANN elections and may work on committees and hold office.

Student

Student membership is open to students who are interested in neonatal nursing and who are currently enrolled in an entry-level nursing program that leads to eligibility for the NCLEX examination upon graduation. Student members have the right to vote in NANN elections. They may work on committees but may not serve as a committee chair or hold office.
